你想进入一个多元文化的学习环境，对跨文化现象有研究的兴趣吗？丹麦奥胡斯大学邀请与我们有合作关系的中国大学的学生参加由奥胡斯大学主办的国际暑期班课程。时间从2016年7月25日到2015年8月12日。课程包括一周的网上学习以及二周的学习研究。

COURSE DESCRIPTION

课程内容和目标

大学毕业后很多人会在国外或国内的大公司机构工作。越来越多的工作职位不仅要求你具有较高的文化程度和工作能力，还需要你能够与多元文化背景下的员工有很好的沟通合作。跨文化的交际能力不仅仅只是外语水平的问题，也需要了解多元文化背景以及具有与不同文化观念的人良好沟通的能力。我们的暑期班课程，将让你熟悉这样的环境并使你具备这种知识和能力。我们的课程将会让你有机会置身在这种跨文化的背景中，学习和了解人们的思想观念、表达方式和行为处事等在从一种文化语境到另一种文化语境的转变中呈现的差异。使你在跨文化的交流互动中学会面对职业环境中越来越全球化的挑战。更好地理解不同的文化和不同文化背景下的人群的复杂性，从而提高你在与他人合作中的沟通和交际能力。

COURSE OBJECTIVES

课程宗旨

- 有关国际交流方面的知识和理论。
- 跨文化中文化交流和碰撞的主要问题。
- 使用民族志的方法，学习识别和描述复杂的文化环境和人群关系。
- 将知识理论应用于实际的案例，了解跨文化境遇的复杂性提供具体的操作。
- 在案例中提出解决方案以提高在复杂的跨文化境遇中的交际能力。

TEACHING AND ASSESMENT

教学与评估

教学: 提供跨国公司或国际组织这类典型和丰富的跨文化挑战的实例。通过讲座、学生口头报告以及开放空间、博客、聊天等多种渠道和方式让学生了解和应对具体项目和案例。最后提交书面报告。

考核: 包括积极参与整个教学过程和实习以及最后的书面报告。

Level: Bachelor and Master

TARGET GROUP

Bachelor students in their third or fourth years and Master students.

PRACTICAL DETAILS

Accommodation: Will be arranged for all international participants. You cover the costs at your own expense. You should expect to pay €430.

Application: You apply online at the AU Summer University website (www.au.dk/summeruniversity) from Dec. 1, 2015.

Costs: Participants are expected to cover expenses of travelling, accommodation, living costs and certain social activities.

Credits: 10 points according to the European credit transfer system (ec.europa.eu/education/tools/ects_en.htm). Expected workload equals 280 hours of work, including preparation, attending teaching, preparing and taking exams.

Eligibility: Only students in their third or fourth year of their bachelor programme or Master students are eligible to apply for this course.

Tuition waiver may be granted for students from Fudan University, Shanghai Jiao Tong University, Peking University, Tsinghua University and Zhejiang University if your home institution agrees to use its bilateral exchange programme with Aarhus University. Visa: Chinese participants need a visa to enter Denmark. Please contact the Danish Visa Application Center in Shanghai or Beijing (kina.um.dk/zh-cn) to clarify details. AU Summer University will provide a letter of invitation or any other documentation that you will need in this context. Please pay close attention to deadlines and the fact that the processing time can be rather long.
