

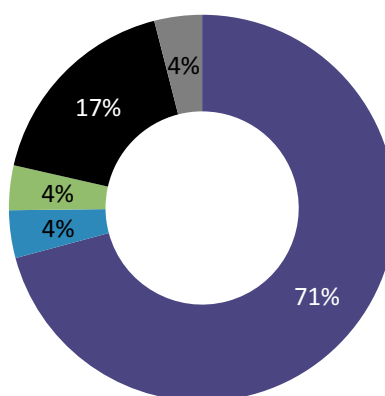
## Great first year for PhD entrepreneurship training

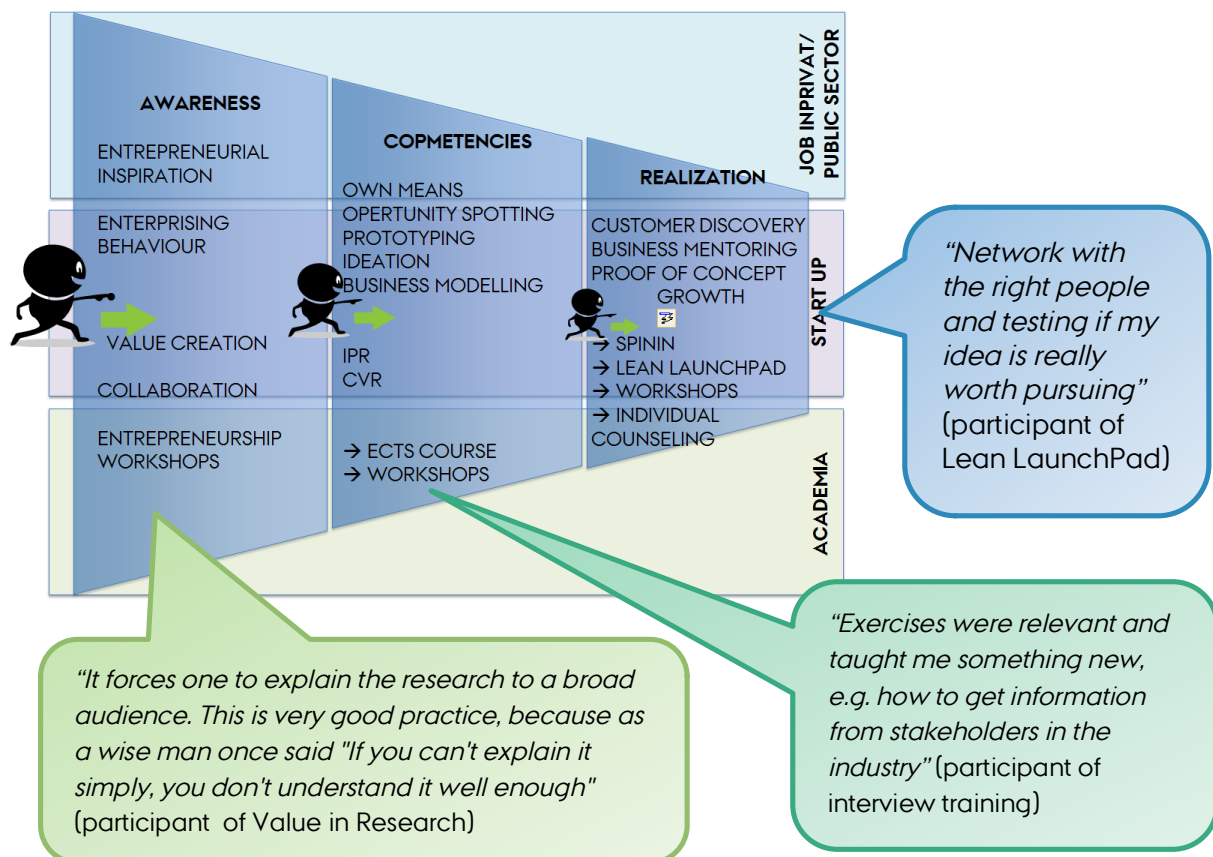
## ENTREPRENEURIAL TRAINING FOR PHD-STUDENTS AND POST DOCS
